## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### ***What is the MSU Alumni Club of Mid-Michigan?***

The MSU Alumni Club of Mid-Michigan is the nations largest MSUAA regional Club. It is *the* hometown club for MSU alums and friends. The Club serves MSU graduates and supporters residing in Ingham, Eaton and Clinton counties. The Club's mission is to "build awareness and support of university programs and to enhance involvement of alumni and friends through activities and community outreach."

### ***Who are the members of the MSU Alumni Club of Mid-Michigan? Am I a member?***

These are very common questions. The answers are actually quite simple. Membership in the MSU Alumni Association (either annual or lifetime membership) gives you automatic membership into your local regional club. A portion of your MSUAA dues fund your regional club. If you are a member of the MSUAA and you reside in Ingham, Eaton, or Clinton county, then you are automatically a member of the MSU Alumni Club of Mid-Michigan. It's that easy. No additional dues! No secret handshakes! No hassles!

### ***Who are the members of the Board? How do I become a Board member?***

Each fall the Board solicits its general membership for energetic and hard working individuals interested in serving. The Board is comprised of eighteen members, six of which comprise the Executive Committee. New members are selected by a nominating committee each November and then put to a vote before the entire Board. Board members serve three year terms. All Board members are typically assigned to a minimum of two committees which require varying degrees of additional work and meeting time. The Board meets the second Wednesday of every month at the offices of the MSU Alumni Association, 242 Spartan Way (Stadium Tower). Meetings typically begin at 5:30 p.m. and usually last around two hours. Any member of the Club is welcome to attend monthly Board meetings.

### ***What are the various committees? When do they meet?***
